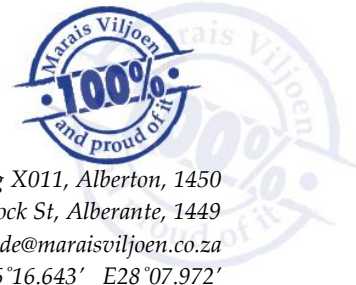

### CIRCULAR 10 (2017)

#### 1. FURY BOOKLETS

Your child has received the Fury booklet. The aim is for each learner to sell **TWO** booklets and, like last year, we have some incentives to motivate the learners. Here they are for you to peruse:

- For each booklet sold the learner may receive either 50 credits or 50 loyalty hours. No more than 200 of either credits or loyalty hours may be awarded.
- Grade 8 and 9 register classes, that have sold an average of two booklets per learner, will have a day off.
- Grade 8 and 9 register classes, that have sold an average of three booklets per learner, will receive an additional day off.
- For Grades 10, 11 and 12 the whole grade will have a day off if an average of two booklets per learner per grade have been sold.
- The class (Grades 8 – 12) that sells the most booklets will go to Sun City for a day.
- Your support with this project will be most appreciated. You are not only supporting the school, but also your child.

#### 2. CHANGING SUBJECTS IN GRADES 10 AND 11

A learner may change a maximum of two subjects in Grade 10, provided this is done by the end of the second term, subject to approval of the Principal of the school where the learner is registered. Such change must be done before 30 June of the Grade 10 year.

A learner may change two subjects in Grade 11, provided this is done before 31 March, subject to the approval of the Principal of the school where the learner is registered.

In exceptional cases a learner may change one additional subject in Grade 11, provided this is done before 15 December of the Grade 11 year.

Therefore, no subject changes may be made in the Grade 12 year.

### **3. LANGUAGE TRANSITION**

If parents decide that a child's language of learning and teaching should change from English to Afrikaans or vice versa, the learner has to have achieved at least an A (80%) in the First Additional Language that he/she wants to make the transition to. The learner also has to write a test in the new language of learning and teaching to assess if he/she will be able to cope.

### **4. INSPECTION**

Please take note that inspection will be done again as soon as school re-opens for the new term.

### **5. SPORT TOURS DURING THE HOLIDAYS**

Our Rugby boys will be taking part in the North-South Derby at Drostyd THS. The Hockey boys and girls and our Netball girls will be touring to Potchefstroom.

### **6. MULTI PURPOSE FACILITY**

The Governing Body has launched a special project with the view of funding a facility which will serve multiple purposes. This facility will be used as a clubhouse, exam room, for cultural activities, exams, or an optional venue for smaller functions. It will be situated in the middle of the hockey, netball and rugby playing areas.
