1. VALENTINE'S DAY

2. FIRST TERM TEST CYCLE

Learners have already received their test timetables for the first term. The test cycle commenced today. Learners must please prepare themselves timeously for their tests.

On a test day the periods will be shorter to accommodate all the periods of the day.

On some days there will be two tests. On these days there will still be school as well, unless the learners are informed of other arrangements.

3. MATHEMATICS ADDITIONAL SUPPORT CLASSES

5. PULLOVER
