### **1. INTER HIGH ATHLETICS MEETING**

### **5. CELL PHONES AND EARPHONES**

Cell phones may not be visible or audible during school hours. Learners not abiding by this rule will have their cell phones or earphones confiscated and locked away in the safe for 3 weeks (Sim cards may not be removed). Learners who are guilty of repeated offences will be deprived of this privilege. Cell phones and earphones are brought to school at own risk. Cell phones may not be charged in classes. Parents must take note that these rules are not negotiable or open for discussion. If it is a learner's only means of communication, the learner and parents have to take responsibility and find another way of communication if the phone has been confiscated.
